This FREE service will ensure library books, DVDs and other items are still available to you despite library doors remaining shut. You can place on specific titles and we will deliver them to your door.

## HOW DO I PLACE MY ORDER?

Log in to your account on our website [ccl.vic.gov.au](http://ccl.vic.gov.au) and choose your own items.

### **A few key points to note about the Home Delivery service:**

- **Please borrow at least 10 items.**
- **Each membership can request a delivery every 14 days**
- **Please allow up to 14 days for delivery, contact-free postage via Australia Post**
- **Don't worry about returning items on time, all CCL loans have been automatically extended until 1 July 2020**
- **To be eligible for Home Delivery you must hold a CCL membership, and live within the Casey Cardinia region.**




