RE-CYCLED SCARECROW Competition

TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2022

HEALs program

Mechanic:

1. Make a family friendly scarecrow using recycled materials.
2. Scarecrow needs to be free-standing and between 1-2 metres high and 1.5 metres wide.
3. Scarecrows will be on display in Pakenham library from 30th April to 8th May 2022.
4. Scarecrows to be collected by creators by Sunday 15th May or they will be recycled.
5. Bookings are essential. Limit of 12 scarecrows (one per family; any number of children to age 15years; parental help allowed)
6. The winner, chosen by library representatives, wins a Bunnings voucher valued at \$100
7. Voting for People's Choice Award is between Sunday 1st May and 4pm Sunday 8th May

T&C's:

- Entrants must be a member of Casey Cardinia Libraries
- One entry per family
- The competition is only open to library members
- Competition opens Monday 4th April 2022 at 9 am (AESDT)
- Entries close Saturday 30th April 2022 at 3 pm (AESDT)
- The winner will be chosen by library representatives.
- Voting for People's Choice Award is between Sunday 1st May and 4pm Sunday 8th May 2022
- All winners will be notified by Tuesday 31st May 2022
- The prize is a Bunnings voucher valued at \$100
- The Bunnings voucher is not refundable or transferrable for cash
- People's Choice prize is a makers/creator's box packaged by Library staff
- CCL isnt responsible for any damage to the scarecrow while on display

- Prizes not collected by 30th June 2022 remain the property of Casey Cardinia Libraries.
- Entrants are responsible for providing their own materials.
- All arrangements for delivering to, and collecting scarecrow from, Pakenham Library, or any out-of-pocket costs, are the entrants' responsibility.
